Principal's Report:

- enrollment is 473 – the highest ever\
- highest numbers in gr. 5 while nice and low among lower elementary classrooms
- Disaster Plaster fundraiser again as a school
- a new Hockey Academy van was purchased
- Hockey Hooky Day is Oct. 8th (either gr. 3-6 or 4-6 TBD)
- SHINE initiative in both LPSD and LCSD – we share a worker, Mira, with St. Thomas who will provide programming on mental health issues to K-6 classrooms
- Bi-provincial pressure – we receive funding from both provinces (SK curriculum and teachers are STF with current bargaining) SASK-costs will go up for LPSD AB- moving to a balanced budget could mean the same or less for LPSD
- new student information system being implemented means a new report card look – same 1-4 scale
- math lead – Craig Blythe – bit of a shift from literacy but still focusing within the math element – daily math facts as an example
- 3 year model to have guided math

- the school will do Disaster Plaster bandaids again
- Hammel's meats again in May/June
