Principals Report

-Human Resources is doing school tours to talk with Support Staff in each building to make connections and to see if there's things that could be improved.

-Division is looking for an operator to set a daycare at Jack Kemp similar to College Park. Is there an opportunity for Rendell for next year?

-Before and after school care- hiring a coordinator plus other duties will start after Easter break -Provincial Budgets (copied the whole slide from Sheldon's report)

AB - same message as last meeting. Small increases but no change in base instructional rate. Moved to a

2 year average instead of 3.

Projections about 300,000 short

SK - collective agreement has stalled some progress. So we still don't know what our funding profile looks like. We have the inflationary increases and can make some assumptions on other things. 1.8% overall increase. Pretty much a wash from our projections.

Still moving forward on budgeting process making a few assumptions so we are ready to go once SK releases the funding profiles.

Class Complexity Component - AB/SK situation puts us at risk. If SK only funds their portion, it puts LPSD in a tough spot. SK needs to fund that portion 100%. (9 teachers, if only funded partially, then it puts the bill on LPSD)

-Anticipate a lower school based budget based on numbers. 100 Grade 5's leaving, 60 kindergarten to grade, 40-50 new kindergarten 25/26. In 2 years we could be 100 students less. (HR is allocating staff next year 374)

-School Playground Fund -Sask government announced new grants for playground equipment. Matching grant up to \$50,000. Our playground equipment is good except for drainage issues and we don't have very many swings. Fall 2025

-Field trips- continue to have parents sign form when registered: in town, no signed permission form, out of town signed permission
